



Harrisonburg-Rockingham Co. High School Student Scholarship

Guidelines

Application Deadline: Tuesday, March 31st, 2026

The Harrisonburg-Rockingham County High School Student Scholarship will be awarded to one student member to help fund his/her pursuit of a higher education.

Eligibility for \$1,000 scholarship:

- CommonWealth One members graduating from a Rockingham County High School including Harrisonburg HS in spring/summer 2026 and attending an accredited college, university or other institution of higher learning in the 2026-2027 academic year.

1. Student applicants must be primary members of CommonWealth One

Applicants must have an account in his or her own name at the credit union. Joint owners are **not** considered primary members.

2. Employees, directors and committee members of CommonWealth One (and their immediate family members) are NOT eligible for this scholarship.

3. Applicants must submit:

- a. Completed scholarship application
- b. Official **sealed** school transcript(s)
- c. Completed activities information and letter of recommendation
- d. An essay of 250-500 words, typed and double-spaced (Please **DO NOT** put your name on your essay)
- e. A recent full color headshot and/or acceptance video interview will be requested if selected as winner. (Photographs and videos will be used in CommonWealth One press releases, social post and advertising).

4. The items above must be sent to CommonWealth One Headquarters and received by **Tuesday, March 31, 2026. Incomplete or late entries will not be considered.**

6. Applicants must be planning to attend an accredited college, university or other institution of higher learning during the 2026-2027 academic year.

will be paid to the appropriate office at the educational institution of choice (must submit proof of registration). Award must be applied to the 2026-2027 academic year.

9. Winner will be notified not later than the beginning of May 2026. Only the winning applicant will receive notification.
