

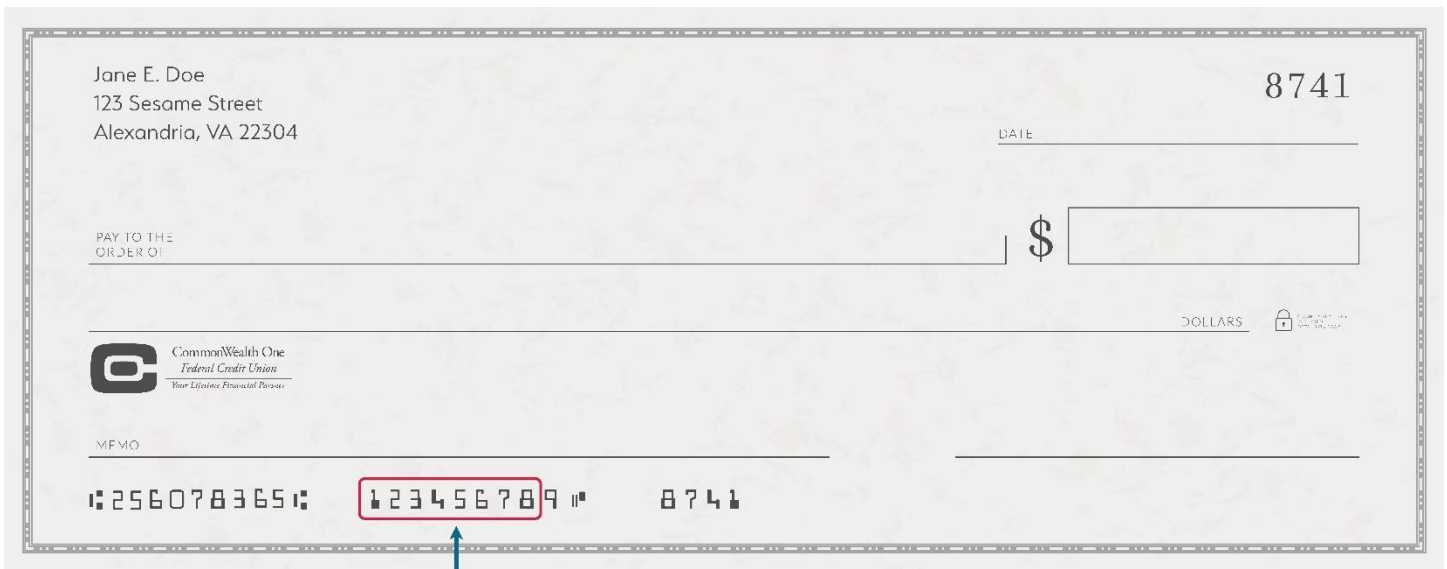
How To Find Your Account Number



Knowing where to locate your account number is essential for setting up direct deposit, automated withdrawals and enrolling in our digital banking service. You can find your account number within mobile banking, on your personal checks, or by contacting us. Below you will find instructions for finding your account number within mobile banking and on your checks.

CommonWealth One Personal Check

If you have a checkbook for your Commonwealth One checking account, you can find your account number within the MICR line which appears at the bottom of your check. Use the example below to identify your account number on your checks:



Your account number appears in the highlighted section above. Note the last digit in this section is omitted. This number is your check digit and is only used for clearing checks or setting up direct deposit or automated debits from your checking account. You should also omit any leading zeros.

CommonWealth One Business Check

If you have a checkbook for your Commonwealth One business checking account, you can find your account number within the MICR line which appears at the bottom of your check. Use the example below to identify your account number on your checks:
