



JMU Orientation Bookstore Gift Card Giveaway Sweepstakes Official Rules

No purchase or transaction requirements necessary to enter or win. Non online account opening entries have an equal chance of winning.

Eligibility: CommonWealth One Federal Credit Union's "JMU Bookstore Gift Card Giveaway" Sweepstakes is open to all legal residents of the United States who are 18 years of age or older at the time of entry. Employees of CommonWealth One Federal Credit Union and their immediate families (spouse, parents, children and siblings, and their respective spouses) and individuals living in the same households of such employees are ineligible. Void where prohibited by law. Prizes subject to all applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations. All winners agree to these official rules.

Entry: Giveaway begins at 12:01am on June 1, 2022 and ends at 11:59pm on July 31, 2022 and is subject to change or termination at any time. Only one entry per person will be accepted. Membership eligibility and minimum \$5 deposit required to open an account. Every person who opens a new account will receive an automatic entry. Closed accounts reopened during this promotion are not eligible

Enter by mail: To enter the Giveaway without opening an account at CommonWealth One Federal Credit Union, you may send your contest entry in an envelope to: "JMU Orientation Bookstore Gift Card Giveaway", CommonWealth One Federal Credit Union, P.O. Box 9997, Alexandria, VA 22304. On the entry, print your name, address and home phone number. Entry must be postmarked by July 31, 2022. Mail-in entries will count as one (1) entry into the drawing. Entries that are mechanically reproduced, copied, illegible, incomplete, or inaccurate and entries by any means which subvert the entry process are void. Entries become the property of the Sponsor and will not be acknowledged or returned. Entries that are incomplete, late, lost, postage-due, mutilated, illegible or contain irregular or invalid information, or are corrupted in any way are void and will not be eligible.

JMU students 18 years of age or older and parents/guardians of JMU students may also enter by texting, "DUKES26" to 843663. Standard message and data rates may apply. Any attempt by any entrant to obtain more than the stated number of entries by using multiple/different/duplicitous identities or any other method will void that entrant's entries and that entrant may be disqualified.

Giveaway drawing: A random drawing will be conducted, by CommonWealth One Federal Credit Union from all eligible entries to award the gift card. Only one gift card winner will be chosen. The odds of winning depend on the total number of eligible entries received; i.e., if 1,000,000 entries are received the odds of winning are 1:1,000,000.

Prize: One \$500 JMU Bookstore Gift Card will be awarded. No substitutions or transfer of prize permitted. CommonWealth One Federal Credit Union will send the winner a 1099-MISC which will represent the value of winning this raffle. Any state or federal taxes that may be owed on prize winnings are the sole responsibility of the individual winner.

Notification: Potential winners will be notified by phone, email, or text by August 16, 2022. Winners will be required to provide identification, sign an affidavit of eligibility and a publicity release or the prize will be forfeited and awarded to an alternate winner. If CommonWealth One Federal Credit Union is unable to contact the potential winner within seven (7) days of the drawing, the prize will be forfeited and awarded to an alternate winner. Acceptance of prize constitutes winner's permission to use his/her name and photo/likeness for advertising and promotional purposes for this and similar promotions, and



in perpetuity in any media, now known or hereafter devised without additional compensation, except where prohibited by law.
